Strengthening the Capacity of Russian Rospotrebnadzor Specialists in the Area of Financial Literacy and Financial Consumer Protection

Customer – Ministry of Finance of the Russian Federation with financial support of the World Bank



Leontief Centre is consultant of the project in consortium Institute for Financial Planning (Moscow). The key objective of the Project is to establish the frameworks for the system of qualification upgrading and retraining of Rospotrebnadzor specialists to ensure effective implementation of financial consumer protection function through conducting urgent training of employees currently responsible for financial consumer protection. Rospotrebnadzor is the Federal Service for Control of Consumers Protection in Russia.

In February in Moscow Region the first intramural training for Rospotrebnadzor specialists of Central, Southern and North Caucasus federal district was held. All participants (74 persons) were successfully trained on previously developed under the Project Program and received certificates of improvement of professional skill.

From February 24 to March 1, the study trip of Rospotrebnadzor specialists (20 persons) to the UK was held. The aim of the study trip is to review the best UK experience in the area of financial consumer protection. As a part of the study trip participants are going to meet leading experts in financial services and consumer protection and visit Financial Services Authority (FSA), Consumers International Global Office, Consumers Association of the UK, Financial Ombudsman Service.

The purpose of study is express analysis of Tatarstan Republic socio-economic and spatial development and preparation of proposals for improvement of strategic planning in the country. Formed several groups of experts from leading Russian and foreign experts, who will present his vision for the development of their areas.

On March 2, 2013 Leontief Centre heads Irina Karelina, Leonid Limonov and Boris Zhikharevich presented to Rustam Minnikhanov, President of Tatarstan Republic summary report on the results of research.

In the framework of presentation were presented reports on following themes - Global Competitiveness of Tatarstan Republic, People. Society. State, Countryside, Transport and Communication Space, Management System of Tatarstan Future, as well as schedule for further work on the project. Rustam Minnikhanov welcomed work of experts and supported its continued development.

Advancing Remote Areas by Development of Cross-Border Via Hanseatica Tourism Route on basis of Local Resources (EstoniaLatvia-Russia Cross-Border Cooperation Programme within European Neighbourhood and Partnership Instrument 2007-2013).



Via Hanseatica (VH) is a tourism route connecting St Petersburg, Narva/Ivangorod, Tartu, Valga/Valka, Valmiera and Sigulda in the Programme territory. In addition to the abovementioned towns, the route passes through areas rich in nature and cultural heritage. As VH is a tourism route passing Russia, Estonia and Latvia, and its potential based on the diversity of these countries, the most efficient and beneficial way to promote VH is doing it via cross-border cooperation. Leontief Centre coordinates the activities of the Russian partners in the implementation of all project tasks and activities of partners from all countries to meet targets for the development of infrastructure and prepare the necessary project and technical documentation. On 6-7 February 2013 in Cēsis (Latvia), Elena Belova, Secretary General of ICSEER Leontief Centre participated in the 4 Working Group meeting "Advancing remote areas by development of cross-border VH tourism route on basis of local resources: VIA HANSEATICA".

During the meeting partners discussed some of main activities such as product development and trainings for VH service provider are in starting process. Also during the meeting participants made first steps towards the VH visibility plan and communication channels (web page, etc.). On March 18-19, 2013 in Ivangorod (Russia) and Narva (Estonia) the First Training Programme on Via Hanseatica Projectn was held. 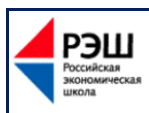

The project has been launched in the framework of the VASAB spatial development initiative in the Baltic Sea Region and implemented by the European Spatial Planning Observatory Network and (ESPON). The aim of the TeMo project is to create a unique methodology system of regular socio-economic, demographic and environmental monitoring in the Baltic Sea. Based on the indicators analysis, the system will help to strengthen territorial cohesion within the entire Baltic Sea Region and increase its competitiveness. Russian side has been represented by the experts from the Ministry of Regional Development, Territorial body of Federal service of the state statistics on St. Petersburg and Leningrad region (Petrostat), the Committee of Economic Policy and Strategic Planning of St. Petersburg, Russian State Institute of Urbanistics as well as from the International Centre for Social and Economic Research - Leontief Centre.
